



- axonometric floor plans




THE INSUFFICIENT PIECE

RECONCEPTUALIZATION OF GENERAL PAZ AVENUE

The project arises from the hypothesis that, in the productive city of the future, urban evolution will enable public transportation to reach more locations, ultimately making the car unnecessary.

Within this framework, and recognizing the existing deficiencies we studied on the highways, we began to redesign the operation of Avenida General Paz—formerly Avenida Jardín. We observed that, beyond having a clear and consistent footprint in the urban fabric, its identity and relationship with its edges change significantly along its entire length. In some areas, the edges are dense; in others, they are more dispersed. Traffic flow is essential in some sections, while in others, it creates obstacles. The avenue widens, intersects with other highways, rises, and buries itself along different stretches.

We then defined a catalog of possible interventions that could be applied to this newly refunctionalized thoroughfare. These interventions take the form of "formulas" that identify different combinations of edges, elevations, uses, and other factors. Each formula contains a series of common denominators—devices that can be applied almost universally along the avenue.




A market.
